What does A.B.A.T.E. do?

- Protects the rights and freedoms of motorcyclist and off-road riders in Illinois, ensuring they are not restricted by unnecessary legislation.
- Advocates for freedom of choice, especially regarding motorcycle related regulations such as gear requirements and riding practices.
- Actively works with state and local legislators to ensure motorcyclists' voices are included in transportation planning and policymaking.
- Serves as a legislation watchdog, monitoring and influencing legislative actions that affect motorcycle rights on the state, national, and even global levels.
- Helps draft motorcycle-related legislation that improves rider safety and protects motorcyclist rights throughout Illinois.
- Conducts extensive safety and education programs for drivers, seniors, legislators, and motorcyclists to increase awareness and reduce accidents.
- Promotes motorcycle safety, acceptance, and enjoyment through statewide educational and community outreach programs.
- Provides discounted legal services to members, offering support for injury cases, wills, and other legal needs through experienced motorcycle rights attorneys.
- Maintains a strong statewide network of more than 60 chapters and over 120,000 members, allowing broad grassroots action and community involvement.
- Organizes advocacy events and rallies, such as Freedom Rallies and Legislative Days, giving riders direct access to lawmakers.
- Publishes newsletters and informational materials to keep riders informed about rights issues, laws, events, and safety education.
- Employs a professional lobbyist to represent motorcycle rights in Springfield, ensuring continuous advocacy in government.

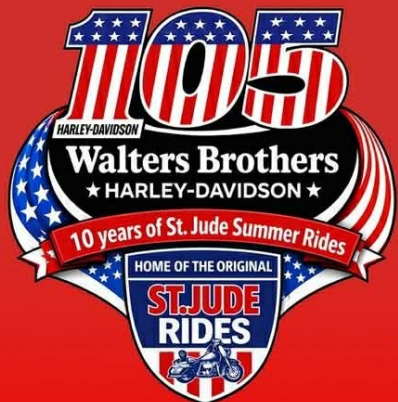

DID YOU KNOW? STAY INFORMED FROM THE MOTORCYCLE RIDERS FOUNDATION(MRF)

"Win For Consumer Right To Repair"

The Motorcycle Riders Foundation (MRF) applauds the recent settlement between John Deere and the Federal Trade Commission (FTC), along with the attorneys general of Wisconsin, Illinois, Michigan, Minnesota, and Arizona regarding consumers' right to repair their own equipment.

While the agreement focuses on agricultural equipment, the states involved represent the heart of America's motorcycling community. These same states are home to countless riders, motorcyclist rights organizations, and independent repair shops that understand the importance of giving owners access to the tools, software, parts, and information needed to maintain their bikes.

We hope this settlement serves as a precedent for other major manufacturers, including motorcycle manufacturers, to recognize that customers should have the right to repair the products they own. Ownership should include the ability to maintain, diagnose, and repair your vehicle.

The MRF is pleased to see the snowballing right to repair results, which continue to consistently support consumer rights. The MRF will continue working with lawmakers, industry partners, and consumer advocates to ensure motorcyclists enjoy the same repair freedoms that Americans expect for every vehicle they own.

A' HO niken,

I hope everyone is having a great safe summer of riding. I know mine has been a shit show. Seems like every time I go riding the winds are 70mph or a pop-up rain happens or the temperature is 100 degrees, Mother Nature is being a bitch this year. All that really doesn't bother but what does is the three close calls I've had with vehicles this year. Two of them were just your average hit your brakes fast because they missed judged me coming at them, but July 5th that date is still imbedded in my head. I was cruising through Hanna City on my 87 FLST heading west passing Casey's and a car coming from the west turned right in front. Everything went still on me, I literally made eye contact with him and his wife, and she was screaming at him while pointing at me. Next thing I knew I clipped their front left bumper or kicked it. I don't know how I didn't go down besides the GRACE of GOD. I pulled over to make sure I was okay and the bike was okay, thankfully I didn't shit myself either. I expected them to stop at Dollar General but guess what, that old boy went flying down the road like he stole the car. I thought about going after him, but I was still in shock that I didn't wreck. I went on my way about ten minutes later after I got my shit back together. That incident has me thinking on how or why I didn't crash. I believe with me practicing counter steering all the time that's what saved me. I should have hit their right front bumper but ended up at the left front bumper. If you don't know what counter steering is, please look it up and practice it. It also made me realize that I had tunnel vision on this ride because I ride that route all the time. I watched him get into the turn lane which I usually slow down in a case like this, but my brain didn't register it. I also think about how people seem to be riding in shorts and tennis shoes these days, I hit their bumper with my foot and luckily, I wear boots when I ride, I feel that I would of broke or lost a few toes if I had been wearing shoes. I do ride in shorts when we are the trike but never on two wheels. So, the long or short of this story is, realize when you are in a tunnel vision state of mind and snap your way out of it quickly. This incident could have been avoided if I was paying attention.

DID YOU KNOW? STAY INFORMED FROM THE MOTORCYCLE RIDERS FOUNDATION (MRF)!

"Presidential Memorandum On Right To Repair"

This week, President Donald Trump issued a Presidential Memorandum aimed at expanding Americans' freedom to repair their own vehicles. The memorandum directs the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to clarify what actions individuals may take when repairing emissions systems under the Clean Air Act, while also encouraging faster and more affordable certification pathways for aftermarket parts.

For motorcyclists, this could be an important step forward. For decades, riders have faced growing barriers to repairing and modifying their own machines, whether due to emissions regulations, restricted access to parts, or manufacturers' control over diagnostics and repair information. The Motorcycle Riders Foundation (MRF) has long supported policies that protect a rider's right to work on their own motorcycle.

However, there remains uncertainty over whether this memorandum will explicitly apply to motorcycles. The language released by the White House focuses broadly on "vehicles," but it is not yet clear if the EPA's forthcoming guidance will include motorcycles in the same way it may cover passenger cars and trucks. That distinction matters. Motorcycles are often treated differently under federal law and emissions regulations, and riders need clarity.

The MRF has been actively engaged on the broader right-to-repair issue in Congress, supporting the Right to Equitable and Professional Auto Industry Repair Act (REPAIR Act), H.R. 1566 and S. 1379, as well as recent provisions advanced through the House Energy and Commerce Committee in the Motor Vehicle Modernization Act.

The MRF will continue to review the Administration's guidance as it develops and will advocate to ensure motorcycles are not left behind. For the MRF, the principle remains simple, if you own it, you should be able to fix it.
