What does A.B.A.T.E. do?

- Protects the rights and freedoms of motorcyclist and off-road riders in Illinois, ensuring they are not restricted by unnecessary legislation.
- Advocates for freedom of choice, especially regarding motorcycle related regulations such as gear requirements and riding practices.
- Actively works with state and local legislators to ensure motorcyclists' voices are included in transportation planning and policymaking.
- Serves as a legislation watchdog, monitoring and influencing legislative actions that affect motorcycle rights on the state, national, and even global levels.
- Helps draft motorcycle-related legislation that improves rider safety and protects motorcyclist rights throughout Illinois.
- Conducts extensive safety and education programs for drivers, seniors, legislators, and motorcyclists to increase awareness and reduce accidents.
- Promotes motorcycle safety, acceptance, and enjoyment through statewide educational and community outreach programs.
- Provides discounted legal services to members, offering support for injury cases, wills, and other legal needs through experienced motorcycle rights attorneys.
- Maintains a strong statewide network of more than 60 chapters and over 120,000 members, allowing broad grassroots action and community involvement.
- Organizes advocacy events and rallies, such as Freedom Rallies and Legislative Days, giving riders direct access to lawmakers.
- Publishes newsletters and informational materials to keep riders informed about rights issues, laws, events, and safety education.
- Employs a professional lobbyist to represent motorcycle rights in Springfield, ensuring continuous advocacy in government.

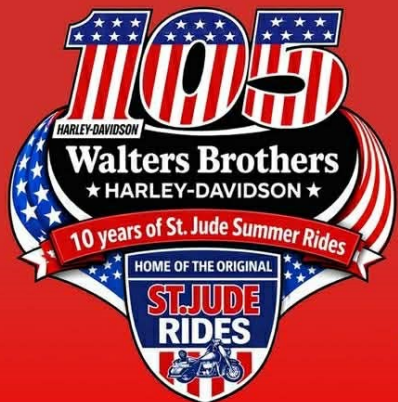

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Safety & Education

DUSTY DIBLER

A'HO Brothers and Sisters. I hope everyone is having a great and safe riding season so far. I hope you read my article in May about fatigue and the pains you get from riding long distances because this is a continuation of that article.

So, I went to see the best Chiropractor ever, Dr. Dean Trotter at Peoria Chiropractic and a member of PEO-TAZ. He asked me if I ever heard of the triangle or 3-point system on a motorcycle. I have not ever heard about the triangle until now, have you? So let me try and explain it to you in laymen's terms and not doctor terms, no offense Dr. Dean.

Let's start with the seat. What is the distance of your seat? Your average seat length should be 14 inches or longer from the tank to the backrest. This gives you room to move around while riding, which helps with pressure points. The second point is how wide are your handlebars? They should be roughly 32 inches wide. Anything shorter pulls your hands in which in return puts your hands on the last third of the grips. Shorter bars make your hands, wrist, forearms, top of shoulders and the neck hurt. The third point of the triangle is the reach from the tank to the handlebars. It should be around 25 inches. Anything under that you begin to push yourself back from the handlebars which also causes fatigue on your arms, shoulders, and back. So, when buying a new bike or updating your old bike think about the triangle so you can have the most comfortable ride possible.

Get measurement from your bellybutton to the handlebars. Is the width of the handlebars good? What is the length of your seat?

"House Votes On E15"

The fight over higher ethanol fuel blends took a major step this week as the U.S. House of Representatives approved H.R. 1346, the Nationwide Consumer and Fuel Retailer Choice Act, by a vote of 218 to 203. The legislation would allow the year-round sale of E15 gasoline nationwide by removing current seasonal restrictions tied to federal smog regulations.

In last week's Motorcycle Riders Foundation (MRF) Legislative Update, we warned that the debate surrounding E15 was beginning to intensify on Capitol Hill. This week's House action confirms that fuel policy will remain a major issue for motorcyclists moving forward.

Supporters of the legislation argue that expanding access to E15 gives consumers more fuel choices and may help reduce fuel prices. Opponents, however, continue to raise concerns about compatibility with existing vehicles and equipment, including motorcycles and other small-engine products not designed for higher ethanol blends.

While the House vote marks an important milestone for the legislation, the battle is far from over. The United States Senate must still consider the bill, where supporters will likely need 60 votes to advance the measure.

The Motorcycle Riders Foundation remains committed to protecting rider access to safe and suitable fuel options. The MRF's top priority in this debate continues to be ensuring the widespread availability of E10 or lower ethanol fuel blends for the motorcycles currently on America's roads.

Legislative Day 2026 was a big success! We were proud to stand with our ABATE of Illinois, chapters in Springfield. We continue to lobby every year at our Capitol as we support the Illinois motorcyclists and the important work ABATE does to promote our rider safety, education, and advocacy across our state. ABATE brings together hardworking people from communities throughout Illinois who care deeply about safety, responsibility, and preserving the traditions they value. Thank you to everyone who continues to make our voices heard and strengthen our incredible organization.
