2022- WHAT DID ABATE DO?

OFF ROAD

Working with IDNR on 1st state Off Road Park- Funded by Federal RTA grants, opens new money for Illinois infrastructure for Park located near Carbondale, expected to open 2024.

Utilized our partnership with IFOR helped state grant funded park. Protect smaller trails designed for Bikes and ATV use from being used by oversize vehicles such as mud trucks and roxors.

Learned that IDNR intends to stop public input on the OHV grant program that ABATE started! This will be a huge fight in 2023/2024.

***2022 What did ABATE do?** Motorcycle safety classes continued to protect the cycle rider safety training as the only source for completion cards.*

Harley Davidson wants these for their private classes.

Learned of new challenges facing the CRSTP rider coach recruitment and training, changing of curriculum.

***Investigated the Harper Colleges** loss of classes in June of 2022. Harper College stopped MSF classes. This was due to "Excessive Liability" determined by the Insurance fund Harper College used because of 2018 court case. ABATE legal services and ABATE investigated the 2018 court case and found why a \$3 million was reached. ABATE of Illinois offered to assist in recruiting a center. ABATE began working with Harper College on legislative solutions to ease the liability aspect.*

***Profiling** -ABATE caused 3 high profile biker style bars to drop their "No Colors" signs. Courtesy of Chris Hansen and Dukane .(Ski has been told to" never visit Psych Silo"). Monitoring the use of tech and police in Chicago who have been targeting groups of riders and bikers. This includes ordinances which we have been told are unconstitutional. Abate refused to endorse 2 SOS candidates who passed these ordinances. Continued conversations with Illinois Gaming Board of Enforcement, Department of Harassment of Bars where 1% groups occasionally stop for drinks. this is just the tip of our efforts! 



There are a handful of you out there that ride your motorcycles during the winter either because you have no choice or because winter riding doesn't really bother you. Either way, you may run into a dilemma with your motorcycle if you live in a place that gets below freezing and/or snows a lot during the winter: road salt. Road salt is essential for people who are riding their vehicles in the winter because it melts ice. Motorcyclists have a love/hate relationship with it because it clears the road for them to ride on but also can cause some damage to their motorcycle if not treated quickly enough.

So, what damage does road salt do to motorcycles? If left untreated, road salt has the potential to speed up the rusting process on a motorcycle as well as has the potential of fading and eating away at the paint on a motorcycle gas tank and frame. Road salt can still get on a motorcycle even if the roads seem dry in between winter storms. If you ride your motorcycle in the winter, you're at a higher risk of your motorcycle being affected by road salt. If left unchecked, the salt can cause damage that may go unnoticed for a while until it's too late. Luckily there are several steps you can take to prevent corrosion while still enjoying your winter riding. The damages road salt can have on a motorcycle is quite different than the damages of other vehicles. Motorcycles are much less protected and everything on it is exposed to road salt. Salty water can find its way in little cracks and crevices on motorcycles that we didn't even know existed. Road salt has the potential to speedily rust any steel parts of your motorcycle, which is what motorcycles are mostly made of. If you have a carburetor with pod filters instead of an air box, you run a higher risk of road salt getting inside your engine. Rust is not any friendlier to the inside of engines and has every potential of rusting if road salt gets inside.

The number one thing you can do to prevent road salt damage is washing your motorcycle thoroughly every 2-3 weeks throughout the winter, even if you don't ride that much. This will wash off any salt that may have gotten on it, especially after the last time you took it to the car wash and rode it home. You can also try applying ACF-50 which is an anti-corrosion treatment. This treatment sprays a type of film on your motorcycle that prevents corrosion from happening and spreading, whether there is rust already forming or not. ACF-50 emulsifies moisture, meaning it causes any moisture around the metal to migrate to the outside of the film. This is a perfect way to repel road salt for your motorcycle. It's easy to spray on and is nonflammable nor does it stain, so you don't have to worry about where it gets. You can literally spray it everywhere on your motorcycle without a worry. For the best protection on your motorcycle from road salt, you should both wash it and add the ACF-50 solution. You will need to add more ACF-50 solution on to your motorcycle about every other time you wash it to ensure you have a solid layer of it on your motorcycle. 

BIKER LASAGNE

Ingredients

2 tbsp olive oil
2 onions finely chopped
3 celery sticks, finely chopped
2 carrots ,finely chopped
3 garlic cloves, finely chopped
750g minced beef
250 ml red wine
600g canned tomatoes
1 tsp ground oregano
2 bay leaves
Sea salt and black pepper

To Assemble

9 dried lasagna sheets
300g ricotta
400g mozzarella
100g Parmesan, grated bunch of basil, shredded, a few whole reserved for the top

Method

1. First make the meat sauce. Heat a tablespoon of the oil in a large pan and add the onions, celery and carrots. Cook over a gentle heat until the onions are translucent and soft , then add the garlic and cook for a further 3-4 minutes.
2. Add the remaining oil to a large frying pan. Fry the beef, leaving it until a brown crust has developed on the underside before breaking it up and turning it over. It's best to do this in a few batches –if you crowd the pan the meat will stew in its own juices instead of searing..
3. Add the beef to the vegetables, then turn the heat up high and add the red wine . Boil until the wine is reduced by at least half, then add the tomatoes and herbs. Season with salt and pepper. Bring back to the boil, then turn down the heat, cover and simmer for an hour. Remove the lid and continue to simmer, stirring regularly, until the sauce has reduced down-this will probably take 15 minutes.
4. Preheat the oven to 200 degrees C /fan 180 degrees C/gas6. To assemble the lasagna, spread a third of the meat sauce in the base of rectangular ovenproof dish, large enough for 3 sheets of lasagna. Cover with lasagna sheets and then add another third of the meat sauce. Spoon 100g of the ricotta in teaspoons over the sauce. Add 100g of the mozzarella and a few basil leaves.
5. Add another layer of pasta and repeat with the quantities of meat sauce and cheeses. Top with a final layer of pasta, the remaining meat sauce, mozzarella and ricotta, then sprinkle the parmesan on top.
6. Bake in the oven for 45-50 minutes until the pasta is cooked through and the top is a rich dark brown and bubbling. Remove the lasagna from the oven and leave stand at least 10 minutes before cutting.


